These transfer petitions have been filed by the petitioner-wife seeking transfer of the following cases:

(i) Complaint Case No. 18727 of 2025, titled "*Anuj Kathuria Vs. Kawaljit Kaur Sachdev*", pending before the Court of Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate, New Delhi District, Patiala House Courts, New Delhi to the City Civil Court at Dindoshi, Mumbai, Maharashtra.

(ii) C.S. (OS) No. 102 of 2025, titled "*Anuj Kathuria Vs. Kawaljit Kaur Sachdev & Ors.*", pending before the High Court of Delhi to the City Civil Court at Dindoshi, Mumbai, Maharashtra.

(iii) H.M.A. No. 630 of 2025, "*Anuj Kathuria Vs. Kawaljit Kaur Sachdev*", pending before the Ld. Principal Judge, Family Court, Amritsar, Punjab, to the Court of Ld. Principal Judge, Family Court, Bandra, Mumbai, Maharashtra.

2. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and after hearing learned counsel for the parties, the prayers in the Transfer Petitions are allowed and the subject-cases are transferred to the respective Courts at Mumbai, Maharashtra.

3. After the matters are transferred to the Courts at Mumbai, Maharashtra, the concerned Courts will give fresh notice to the parties by fixing a date and the aforesaid matters shall proceed before the said Court from the stage they were before the Courts at Delhi and Punjab.

4. The respondent is at liberty to move an application before the transferee courts seeking permission for his presence through virtual mode, which shall be considered in accordance with law, depending on the infrastructure and facilities available at that Court.

5. As prayed for by learned counsel for the respondent-husband, it shall be open to him to move before the City Civil Court at Dindoshi, Mumbai, Maharashtra, for early hearing/expediting the proceedings in C.S. (OS) No. 102 of 2025 after its transfer.

6. The records of the case be transferred to the transferee Courts forthwith.

7. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
